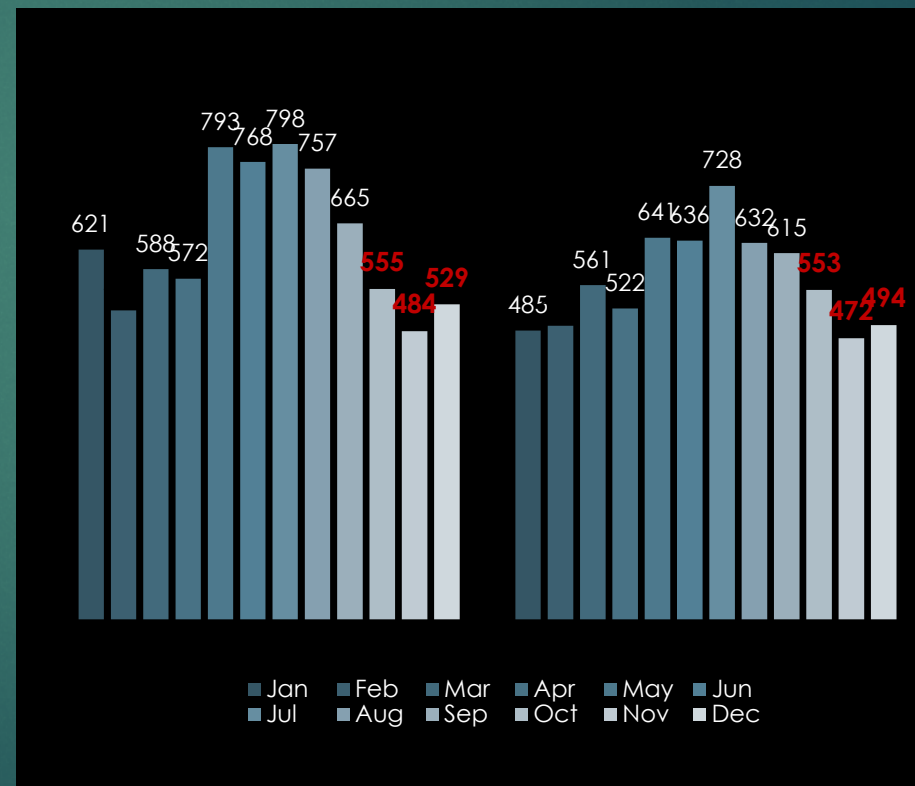

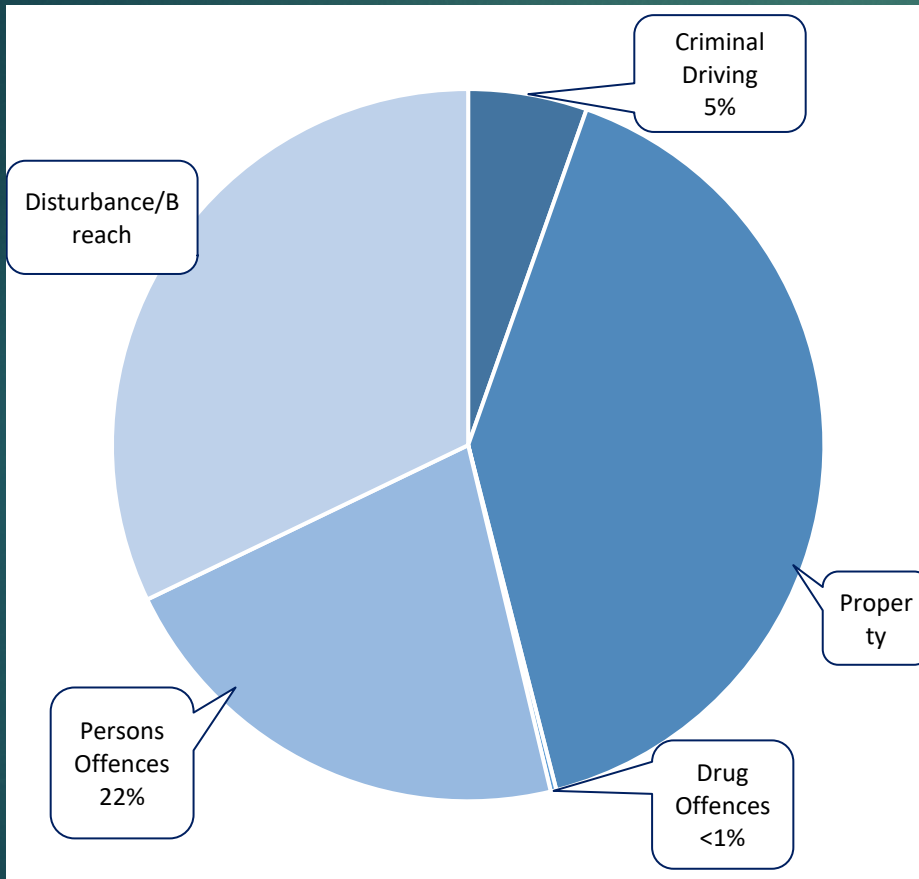

# Community Policing / Victim Services

- ▶ Community Policing /Victim Services is comprised of a full time coordinator, 3 casual community policing assistants, and 30 volunteers
- ▶ 3 community policing assistants have specific portfolios: Block watch / CPTED/ Business watch, social media, community programs.
- ▶ Community Police Volunteers logged 2196 hours in 2024
- ▶ Victim services has 3 trained volunteers, 2 of which are currently available to assist clients
- ▶ Victim services supports an average of 70 clients a month
- ▶ Victim Services volunteers have logged 100 hrs in 2024.

# Community Policing / Victim Services – New programs in 2024

- ▶ Citizens on Patrol- teams conduct general patrols of commercial area's and pro-actively engage with community members.
- ▶ Vacation Home Checks- volunteers will conduct basic checks on exterior of property for those who register for program while the occupants are away
- ▶ Meal Delivery- Partnering with Cloverdale Community Kitchen to deliver meals to seniors, individuals with chronic or acute medical conditions and/or people recovering from illness or injury.
