
- Public spaces and greenspaces

- Update and simplify permitting processes



Land uses they would like to see in the area


- Increase heights and density to match Semiahmoo Town Centre

- More mixed-use development








How could we take advantage of the proposed Bus Rapid Transit line to White Rock?


