

Oxford Hill Climb

Event Summary

- A bicycle race where cyclists ride up the famous Oxford hill one at a time "against the clock".
- Proposed date: June 24, 2023, 9:00am 1:00pm
- Organized by United Velo Cycling Club.

Benefits

- Showcase the City of White Rock by attracting riders and spectators from around the Lower Mainland and beyond.
- Very spectator friendly since cyclists are travelling at a relatively low speed.
- Promote physical fitness and a healthy lifestyle.
- Accessible to a diverse range of participants. Road/gravel/mountain/fixie bikes are allowed (must be human-powered and in safe working order).
- Affordable entry fee.
- Low impact with just one short road closure section.

United Velo Cycling Club

- Started in 2015 with over 200 members throughout Greater Vancouver and the Fraser Valley including White Rock, Surrey, Langley, etc.
- Experienced at race organization including three successful road races completed this year in the Township of Langley.
- Large pool of volunteers.
- Member of Cycling BC.
- \$10,000,000 race event insurance through Cycling BC.

Event Safety

- Certified First Aid attendants will be on site.
- Professional traffic control.
- Helmets required to be worn by riders any time they are on a bicycle.
- All bicycles must be in safe working order.
- Restrooms are located in the building on the south side of Marine Drive and Oxford Street.

Event Specifics

- Primary parking at the South Surrey Indoor Pool parking lot.
- The course is 700 meters long with 80 meters of elevation gained.
- Riders will depart every minute on the minute from the start area on Oxford Street where it meets Buena Vista.
- The course finishes with a left-hand turn off of Oxford Street onto Russell Avenue. Cyclists then continue into the Oxford Hill Church parking lot.
