Addresses systemic gaps existing for underserved communities across BC in accessing equitable solutions to complex health, social, and economic challenges.


Initially offered free and low cost sports programming for children and youth to reduce financial barriers to participation. Activities have expanded to include:

- Health education and resources

Located at Centennial Park

Operated by Engaged Communities in collaboration with City of White Rock

Open November 9 - March 31 from 7am-10pm

Capacity to support up to 30 people. Accommodated ~2860 visits over 143 days.



### Services

- Basic needs supports
- Overdose response and crisis intervention
- On site physicians, nurses, counsellors, and social workers
- System navigation support and program referrals/registration
- Transportation
- Activities and entertainment
- Emotional and conversational support
- Cleaning services shelter, Centennial Park, and nearby areas. Removed litter/paraphernalia.











#### • Peer empowerment


- Provide opportunities for paid roles contributing to guest's well-being and working towards achieving personal goals

- Intersectoral collaboration and public awareness



  - Forum to test, evaluate, and validate approaches
