









Territorial Acknowledgment



Chorus Apartments

A Benefit to the Community

- Completed in 2016, Chorus was the first purpose-built rental building in Surrey in years. It has won awards for its form and its inclusive tenancy.
- Chorus features 71 affordable rental homes (3 long-term leases), of which 20 have tenants who have developmental disabilities.





Harmony Apartments

Needed in Surrey

Modeled on award-winning Chorus, Harmony was to be built on 5.5 acres of property UNITI owns in South Surrey. A perfect location, close to transit, shopping, and employment.

The most supported affordable housing project in BC's history and strong City staff support--it was still rejected by Council before being approved unanimously at 3rd Reading in January, 2021
