### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This corporate report presents Council with the final 2025–2029 Financial Plan document, updated to incorporate all amendments adopted through *White Rock Financial Plan (2025–2029) Bylaw, 2025, No. 2534*, and *Amendment No. 1, 2025, No. 2539*, which received final reading at the July 7, 2025, Regular Council Meeting. The Final Plan reflects revised capital and operating budgets, carryforward amounts, and project adjustments based on updated estimates. Once received by Council, the document will be published on the City's website and submitted to the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for consideration under its Distinguished Budget Presentation Award program for the 2025 budget year.

## INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND

This corporate report presents Council with the Final 2025–2029 Financial Plan document. This version incorporates all updates from *White Rock Financial Plan (2025–2029) Bylaw, 2025, No. 2534*, and *Amendment No. 1, 2025, No. 2539*, which received final reading at the July 7, 2025, Regular Council Meeting.

The final 2025–2029 Financial Plan (attached as *Appendix A*) reflects the following key updates included in the amendment bylaw:

• Carryforward of capital projects that were budgeted in 2024 but not completed;

- Carryforward of selected operating expenditures delayed from 2024;
- Removal of Warming Centre budget allocations for years 2026-2029; and
- Revisions to capital budgets based on updated cost estimates and newly identified projects.

These adjustments do not impact the 2025 property tax rates or utility user fees already approved by Council. The document will be published on the City's website and submitted to the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) of the United States and Canada for consideration under their Distinguished Budget Presentation Award program.

Please note that the extended deadline to submit the Financial Plan for consideration for the 2025 budget year is in August 2025.

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The updates included in the final 2025-2029 Financial Plan reflect those included in the *White Rock Financial Plan (2025–2029) Bylaw, 2025, No. 2534*, and *Amendment No. 1, 2025, No. 2539*, as adopted at Council's July 7, 2025, Regular Council meeting.
