Appendix C: Test Parking Receipts displaying the TransLink 29% tax and GST

Example 1: Proposed text wording at the bottom of the parking receipt to explain the parking fee includes the TransLink tax and GST:

Example 2: Limitations of the pay parking software and coin payment impacting the amounts displayed on the receipt

The breakdown of the parking fee showing the taxes included can be done on the receipt but with limitations:

- Pay parking software configuration requires the base fee, if separately displayed on the receipt, to be rounded to a multiple of 5 cents.
- Pay parking software configuration does not allow percentage calculations for the TransLink tax. The tax amount must be entered as a fee amount.
- The gross fee must be in multiples of 25 cents as 5 and 10 cent coins are not accepted at pay stations.
- The rounding adjustment to get to a multiple of 25 cents is included with the parking tax amount resulting in the TransLink tax on the receipt being inaccurate if a customer were to do the math calculation. For example below with the Arena receipt showing parking tax of 62 cents but it should be 58 cents (29% of \$2.00).
