- History of the Semiahmoo First Nations people;
- The White Rock: explore opportunities to collaborate with Semiahmoo First Nation to better maintain, upgrade and recognize this as the iconic namesake of this community;
- Memorial Park name change: form a working group to investigate this idea further; and,
- Storyboards on Semiahmoo First Nation history.
