4. BUDGET RECAP AND DISCUSSION

P. Murray, consultant, provided an update regarding the 2022 draft budget process and noted the following items outlined in the On-Table information:

- RCMP contract costs now formalized, budget needs to be increased by a further \$70,000 to accommodate this
- Grants In Lieu Revenues adjustment to reflect latest changes in utility rates in the amount of \$20,000 (property tax reduction of 0.08%)
- Warming Shelter budget consideration to be made

The following discussion points were noted:

• It was clarified that the COVID grant funds received by the province may be utilized for the warming shelter (although further consideration would need to

be given moving forward - next fall etc. at approximately \$80,000 per month when cost sharing with the City of Surrey)

 Concern noted in regard to information noted under "Council and CAO office expense by type" (every second year for the CAO review is not correct -Policy 126 is to be updated)

Staff noted they would provide information in regard to what the COVID funds have been spent on to date (with other duties this may take up to a month to provide).

Displayed for the committee and the audience was a calculation spreadsheet: 2022 Possible Budget Reductions March 28, 2022.

THAT the Finance and Audit Committee direct that the COVID grant funds be utilized to fund the warming shelter for spring 2022.
