RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Finance and Audit Committee endorse the proposed “Fees and Charges Bylaw, 2020, No. 2369, Amendment No. 1, 2021, No. 2370.”

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This bylaw amendment is a housekeeping amendment. It was discovered after the 2021 Fees and Charges Bylaw, 2020, No. 2369 was presented to Council for three readings on December 7, 2020, that the Auditorium rental fees for the Kent Street Activity Centre under schedule G were incorrect. This bylaw amendment corrects those fees.

INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND

During the preparation of the Fees and Charges Bylaw in December of 2020, an error was made in schedule G for the Kent Street Activity Centre as follows:


