PIER ENHANCEMENT

1.THAT the Marine Drive Task Force request that Council consider that within the current budgeting process funds be allocated towards enhancement of the pier, subject to funding being made available for the reconstruction of the pier.

ALL AGES PUBLIC SPACE ON MARINE DRIVE

2. THAT the Marine Drive Task Force request that Council consider that within the current budgeting process funds be allocated towards creating flexible (all-season/ all-ages) public space on Marine Drive. **STATUS: November 4 Council meeting – endorsed.**

CACs FOR WAYFINDING / STORYTELLING IN ENGLISH & SENCOTEN

3. THAT the Marine Drive Task Force requests that Council consider allocating Community Amenity Contribution (CAC) funds for signage (in English and Sencoten) to support Semiahmoo First Nation storytelling and wayfinding on the waterfront.

EXPO BENCH REPLACEMENT

4. THAT the Marine Drive Task Force recommends that Council request that staff investigate the feasibility of replacing the Expo benches with the bench design used in the refurnishing of East Beach; and,

THAT staff looks a ways to recycle/ reuse the Expo benches.

CONSISTENT GARBAGE CANS/RECYCLING ON MARINE

5. THAT the Marine Drive Task Force recommends that Council request that staff investigate the feasibility of installing a consistent style of garbage/ recycling cans along the Promenade and Marine Drive sidewalks.

COMFORT STATIONS UPGRADE

- Information signage (animal and wildlife related signs);
- Connecting trails and bike routes;
- Pathway access;
- Semiahmoo First Nations Lands;
- Exits to the Town Center
- Bus Stops
