Dear Environment Committee,

I would like to highlight the issue of the continued use of 'Round Up' and other pesticides/herbicides in community and would appreciate your help. As background, every spring, my neighbour uses a weed trimmer and then soaks his back yard in 'Round-Up' so that he doesn't need to mow again for the year. It's so bad that we can smell it for days after treatment. I was sharing this story with a friend who told me that pesticides (and herbicides) are not actually allowed in White Rock. As usual, he was correct when I found and reviewed the bylaw :0). I have attached it for your reference.

I don't use them, but I'm thinking that I can't be the only one who didn't know that use of herbicides/pesticides isn't permitted in White Rock. I think it would be useful for the committee to promote to council a reminder style communication/education program about the bylaw, including minimum fines clearly noted in the bylaw. A couple of communication opportunities might be including a note on it in the utility bill flyer that has watering rules on it, as well as posting it more prominently on the city website (perhaps along with watering rules).
