5. LIT BENCH REVIEW AND DISCUSSION

The Vice-Chairperson shared preliminary information with the Committee at this time, with the intent to have a more thorough discussion at the next scheduled meeting, when staff liaisons will be included.

ACTION ITEM: Staff to reach out to other municipalities who have accepted lit bench donations, regarding what their practices are around lighting schedules, costs, etc.

6. OVERVIEW OF INITIATIVES AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF THE 2021/2022 PUBLIC ART ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Committee member, G. Kennedy, provided an overview of key initiatives and accomplishments of the 2021/2022 Public Art Advisory Committee.

ACTION ITEM: Staff to provide Committee with an update on the Saltaire public art project and the Monaco mural project at the next scheduled meeting.

The following topics were discussed during this overview:

- Walkways throughout the City that could benefit from placemaking initiatives, rather than just being a route from A to B;
- Possibility of incorporating a green/living wall at the West Beach Parkade (to be added in the "TO DO IN ONE YEAR" placemaking table), with potential assistance from the Parks department;
- Creating/installing an arched gateway "Welcome" sign at the intersection of Johnston Road and North Bluff Road; and,
- Street art banners and the logistics around successful installation, potential frequency for banners to be changed to reflect different themes/seasons.

ACTION ITEM: Committee Clerk to invite the Director of Engineering and Municipal Operations to attend an upcoming meeting, to discuss opportunities and logistics for his team to support future placemaking initiatives of this Committee.

Committee member, G. Kennedy, then provided a PowerPoint presentation regarding opportunities for murals, as well as a mural festival, in White Rock. A roundtable discussion followed.

7. PLACEMAKING AND THE DISTRICTS OF WHITE ROCK

The Chairperson and Committee members who submitted placemaking suggestions prior to the meeting provided brief overviews of their ideas, followed by roundtable discussion and feedback from other members.

<u>ACTION ITEM:</u> Committee Clerk to add "Publish a weekly Peace Arch News ad which would advise community of relevant public art and culture events/initiatives happening" to the "TO DO NOW" placemaking table (for all districts).

THAT the Public Art and Culture Advisory Committee recommends that Council approve the City celebrating the 40th anniversary of the Whale Wall with a heritage designation ceremony on Sunday, September 29, 2024, with the inclusion of community activities to accompany the event.
