

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
CITY OF WHITE ROCK
BYLAW 2502**



A Bylaw to amend the “White Rock Parks Regulations Bylaw,”
as amended, in regards to loitering in the waterfront park areas

The CITY COUNCIL of the Corporation of the City of White Rock, in an open meeting assembled, ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the “*White Rock Parks Regulations Bylaw 1977, No. 675, Amendment No. 8, 2024, No. 2502*”.

2. The White Rock Parks Regulations Bylaw, 1977, No. 675, is amended as follows:

(a) at section 1, the interpretation of “Section A” and “Section B” are deleted and replaced with the following:

“Promenade” means the walkway and adjacent grassy areas adjacent to the BNSF railways tracks and Semiahmoo Bay, owned and maintained by the City

and

“Pier” means the White Rock Pier located on District Lot 595 owned and maintained by the City

(b) at section 2, by repealing paragraph (j);

(c) by renumbering section 7 as subsection 7.1; replacing “pier” with “Pier”; and adding the following as subsections 7.2 and 7.3:

7.2 No person shall loiter or remain in the waterfront park areas shown outlined on Schedule A [Promenade, Pier, Bayview Park, Memorial Park and Grand Chief Bernard Robert Charles Memorial Plaza] between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 am on any night.

7.3 Schedule A is attached to and forms part of this Bylaw.

and

(d) by adding to the Bylaw Schedule A in the form attached to this Bylaw.
